Location:

The Dorsey Museum is located in the lower level of the Pense Learning Center on the campus of Evangelical Seminary, and the main entrance is directly accessible from the upper parking lot. The Seminary's address is 121 South College St., Myerstown, PA 17067.

Parking:

There is off-street parking near the front entrance of the Museum and street parking along Park Avenue. Turning west off of PA-501 onto West Park Avenue, the parking lot will be the first driveway on the right.

Accessibility:

The museum is accessible to wheelchair users and other visitors unable to use stairs. All entrances, artifact collections, and bathroom facilities are accessible.

When are tours available?

Guided group tours of the museum are scheduled upon request. You can request daytime, evening, or weekend tours. All requests should be made at least two weeks in advance of your desired date of visit. We will work hard to accommodate your requested time, but appreciate your understanding if no tour guides are available for your requested time. Please contact us by phone or email to schedule a guided tour. Please include: your name, contact information, and preferred date(s) and time of visit.

Size of group:

For a guided tour, we request a minimum of 5 people and we can accommodate groups up to 25 people.

What is involved in a guided tour?

The standard guided tour involves a twenty minute to half hour introductory presentation to the Dorsey museum, the land of Israel, and archaeology given in the museum classroom. The presentation will be followed by a guided tour of the collection explaining the exhibits and highlighting various artifacts (approximately 45 minutes).

What is the cost?

Suggested per person rates for a guided group tour are as follows:

Adults: \$8.00

Seniors or Students: \$7.00

Children (ages 5-12): \$6.00

How do we pay?

Currently, we are only able to accept cash or checks. Checks should be made payable to "Evangelical Seminary." Payment is appreciated at the time of the tour and will be handled by the tour guide or museum staff member.
